



## **Denise Martinez Scholarship Fund**

**Objective:** Provide assistance for deserving youth who will be pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited school. The award shall be based on merit and need.

**Funding:** Funds will primarily be raised at the annual Martinez Member-Employee Golf Tournament. Additional funds may be raised from other activities held at Martis Camp.

**Award:** One \$10,000 award annually, to be paid \$2,500 annually for up to 4 years. If funds allow, \$500-\$1,000 awards may be made to individuals on an annual basis.

**Committee:** Mark Johnson, Carla Yeager, Gus Jones.

**Cycle:** Committee will meet once annually in May to determine the recipient for the upcoming school year. Applications will be screened by the Truckee Tahoe Community Scholarship Committee, who will recommend qualified students for MCCF review.

### **Guidelines:**

- Applicant must be a high school senior enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited school in the Truckee-North Lake Tahoe Unified School District.
- Preference will be given to students who are employees or caddies of Martis Camp, or whose parents are employed by MC. Preference will also be given to students who play golf on a team or as a pastime.
- Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0, and plan on attending school in the fall of the year the scholarship is awarded.
- Applicant's family household income will be considered, and tax returns must be provided upon request.
- Extra-curricular activities should be included, and up to three letters of recommendations from teachers, coaches, employers, etc., will be considered.
- Applicants must embody the ideals and qualities of Denise Martinez – hard work, fair play, kindness and integrity.
- After an award is accepted, the student must maintain a 3.0 GPA throughout the school terms for which the scholarship is paid. A transcript of each semester's grades should be forwarded to the MCCF.
