Among golfers at Martis Camp, there's a brief, agreed upon slowdown that takes place on the third tee. To their right as they tee up is a home of many stunning angles of window, wood and iron and a set of decks with elevated views of the par three hole. It's a pause of appreciation for a sight that's nothing short of stunning. But what's within the home is even far more impressive. Just beyond the front door of this 3,247-square-foot home, you're confronted with a decision: down to the left, or up to the right.
